Thought for the Day In his book “Understanding the Times” David Noebel described the difference between worldviews. **Theology-Secular Humanism (SH), Marxist (M):** -atheism, **Biblical Christianity (BC)** - Theism; **Ethics- SH**-ethical relativism; **M-proletariat morality (state decides what is moral), BC-** Ethical absolutes; **Biology- SH** Darwinian Evolution; **BC-**special creationism. **Sociology- SH**-non-traditional world state ethical society; **M** – abolition of home, church and state; **BC-** Home, church and state. **Politics- SH-** World government (globalism); **M-** New world order **BC-** Justice, Freedom and order. **Economics- SH, M-** socialism; **BC-** Stewardship of property; We look today at this comparison and we look at America. Is the state dictating that evolution is true? Is morality relative? Is gender decided by God at conception? Are parents best equipped to teach right and wrong and morality to our children or does the state step in and tell a child you get to decide if you want to be a boy or girl.
