Then once the country was set to re-open a man was murdered by a police officer leading to demonstrations which started peacefully but ended with looting, arson and murder. Racism gets the blame but in reality, the source of turmoil is Satan and the condition of the human soul without the guidance of God. We are witnessing a clash of worldviews. The secular worldview; Common, Acceptable and Normal is constantly changing and moving. Change occurs when society says a common behavior; racism is no longer acceptable. Perfect means it follows an objective standard which can be found in the Bible. **Romans 12:1–2** ¹I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, *which is* your reasonable service. ² And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what *is* that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
