Thought for the day Today is the day the church celebrates resurrection Sunday. For us it means so much. **Romans 10:9-10** That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt *believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead*, thou shalt be saved. ¹⁰ *For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. The result of our believing is righteousness. Believing in the resurrection opens a potential for a changed life. Once we are saved the Holy Spirit comes to live inside of us. We will be able to sense God's presence, feel his power, understand preaching and be able to understand the Bible. Paul calls this spiritual discernment in 1 Corinthians chapter 2. People who do not believe in Jesus will think we are crazy when we tell them God speaks to us and reveals his will for us. They can't understand because what we know to be true can only be understood by someone who has the Holy Spirit living inside. Satan will use them to introduce doubt into our minds. The fact of the resurrection of Jesus brings with it other facts. Fact, man is saved through faith Jesus, fact the Holy Spirit reveals God to us, fact God invites us to pray, fact our life can be transformed through God's power, fact there is a place called heaven and that is where we will spend eternity. When we accept the facts about the results of the resurrection then we can feel a peace that comes when we have a soul at rest in Jesus. **Pastor Bruce***

Junior Disciples: AM Church Service

Today we are continuing curriculum called "The Core". Over the next year we'll be learning about the 8 "roots" of discipleship, Apologetics, Community, Identity, Kingdom, Knowledge, Outreach, Rescue and Worship. This week we'll continue in our "Apologetics" root. A lot of young people see a disconnect between the truth found in the Bible and what they'd consider "real world" truth. They think these things are separate. This lesson focuses on the idea that all truth is God's truth. The absolute truth of the Bible is true all the time and everywhere, and this truth matches up to the world we live in. The Bible has a lot to say about this (the word "truth" shows up a couple hundred times in the Bible), and this lesson's Bible study will take a look at a few of these instances. You'll also read about a few scientists who decided to study the way the world works *because* of faith in God and others who started pursuing a relationship with God because of what they discovered through science. There is also a parent's guide that goes along with these lessons that includes activities your families can do to continue learning during the week.
